These requests come from the Legislature (usually the Health Committees). CHBRP mainly analyzes benefit-related mandates (i.e., mandates to cover a test, treatment, or service).

At this year's legislative briefing, we will discuss the analytic approach CHBRP uses and demonstrate how CHBRP serves as a bridge between academia and the policy-making process within the Legislature's fast timeline.
